DLT Honors Former Campaign Chair

On Sunday, July 29th, Downeast Lakes Land Trust held its Annual Meeting and Picnic on the shores of West Grand Lake. Coupled with a benefit auction, this annual event also marks the announcement of the Downeast Lakes Conservation Award. This year's recipient is longtime DLLT supporter and volunteer, John "Jake" Lea. This annual award was created to honor those who have made extraordinary contributions toward the economic and environmental well-being of the Downeast Lakes region.

Jake has lifelong ties to the Grand Lake Stream area and has been an instrumental force for the work of DLLT since its inception in 2001. He first served as the Downeast Lakes Forestry Partnership (DLFP) leadership committee chair, which led to the conservation of more than 340,000 acres in the region and the DLLT purchase of 27,000 acres for the creation of what would become the Downeast Lakes Community Forest. Jake played a key role in negotiating and guiding this partnership between DLLT and the New England Forestry Foundation, which raised more than \$30 million dollars for conservation in our region. After the success of the DLFP, Jake served on the fundraising committee for the subsequent Wabassus Lake Project and co-chaired the West Grand Lake Community Forest Project.

"When DLLT ordered a feasibility study to assess fundraising potential for the Downeast Lakes Forestry Partnership, the results were underwhelming," notes DLLT Executive Director David Montague. "Estimates for funds that could be raised for such an ambitious campaign fell far below what was needed. It is to Jake's credit that he was undaunted by these disappointing figures; he put his nose to the grindstone and helped DLLT raise funds far surpassing the estimates. That took courage and a strong commitment to our mission – both

qualities that are embodied by recipients of the Downeast Lakes Conservation Award.”

Lapstrake Canoe Raffle!

Downeast Lakes Land Trust is holding a special raffle, where all proceeds will directly contribute to the campaign to build the new DLLT Headquarters in Grand Lake Stream. The winning item is a 15' Lapstrake "Warden's" Canoe, with a single and a double-bladed paddle. This beautiful canoe has a removable carry thwart and backrest. Hand-built by renowned boat builder Geoff Burke of Chocorua Boatworks in Tamworth, NH, circa 1985. A proven design, built to allow wardens to silently and

swiftly paddle up on suspects! This is a great solo boat, and can handle two lighter people. Copper-riveted construction features cedar, tamarack, cherry, ash, and oak.

It has been stored indoors and is in excellent condition.

This flatwater paddle race is a family-friendly event that has become a Grand Lake Stream favorite! All non-motorized watercraft are invited to participate in race distances of 4, 6, or 12 miles. Prior to the longer distances, we will host a special “kids race” for everyone to enjoy. Registration will be held from 9:15 – 10:15 am, followed promptly by a pre-race meeting at 10:30 am.
