Is the tree a deciduous (loses leaves in fall) or coniferous (evergreen) tree? Is it tall? Does it have fruits or flowers on it?

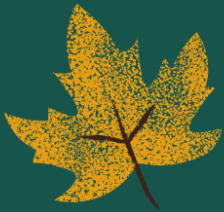
ASK AN EXPERT
